



Driving restrictions and adjusted departures April and May 2018

Hereunder you will find details for a number of countries. Owing to the restrictions and holidays referred to we are unable to guarantee our regular lead times.

Please pay special attention to week 19. On 8 and 10 May there will be a national holiday in France. Please take this into account when placing your orders. Due to this 'special' week, the term may vary.

Wednesday 25 April 2018 – Liberation Day in Italy and Liberty Day in Portugal

Wednesday 25 April 2018 is a national holiday in Italy and Portugal. There will be a complete ban on freight traffic movement; this applies to Italy and Portugal as a whole.

Friday 27 April 2018 – King's Day in the Netherlands

Friday 27 April 2018 is a national holiday in the Netherlands. On Friday 27 April, no consignments will be collected or delivered in the Netherlands. Collections and deliveries in Belgium will be limited. Van Duuren will be closed on 27 April.

Please place your orders for loading on Monday 30 April no later than 3.00 p.m. on Thursday 26 April.

Tuesday 1 May 2018 – Labour Day and Bank holiday

Labour Day will be celebrated on Tuesday 1 May 2018. This means that no collections or deliveries will take place throughout almost all of Europe.

Tuesday 8 May 2018 – Liberation Day in France, Czech Republic and Slovakia

Tuesday 8 May 2018 is a national holiday in France, Czech Republic and Slovakia. There will be a complete ban on freight traffic movement in the whole of France, Czech Republic and Slovakia.

Thursday 10 May 2018 – Ascension Day

Thursday 10 May 2018 is a holiday in Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden and Switzerland. There will be no deliveries or collections in these countries on this date. Van Duuren will be closed on 10 May. As of Friday 11 May, loading and unloading will take place in these countries according to the normal scheduled times.

In order to avoid misunderstandings and extra costs, we would also urge you to check whether the address at which your consignments are to be delivered or collected are open on Friday 11 May (the day after Ascension Day).

Monday 21 May 2018 – Whitsuntide

Monday 21 May 2018 is a holiday in Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Romania and major parts of Switzerland. There will be no deliveries or collections in these countries on this date. Van Duuren will be closed on 21 May. As of Tuesday 22 May, loading and unloading will take place in these countries according to the normal scheduled times.

Monday 28 May 2018 – Spring Bank Holiday in Great Britain

Monday 28 May 2018 is a national holiday in Great Britain. There will be a complete ban on freight traffic movement in the whole of Great Britain.
